Conversion to Academy Status

As you will be aware Budmouth is now part of the Aspirations Academy Trust. Our conversion was completed on the 1st September. Clearly this is a significant change for us and there will be a number of changes that will be made across the year and lots of new things that staff will be adapting to. At the moment, members of the admin and office teams are getting used to very new systems. Changes that will be coming soon include:

- Moving to an online payment system for parents. Details will follow but, in the meantime, if you need to write a cheque they need to be made payable to Aspirations Academies Trust.
- Making the canteen a cashless facility with biometric technology. This will speed up service in the canteen and the current aim is to introduce this by October half-term. We will keep you updated.
- Student and staff emails will be changing this term as we move over to a Google system. This will be useful for students and means that work they save at school will also be available to them at home. Work will be saved in the 'Cloud' and be available to them anywhere using their password and internet access.
- We will inform you when the staff emails have been changed, but please note the new email address for contacting us with general enquires is: office@budmouth-aspirations.org.
- A new website is in the process of being finalised by the central Aspirations ICT team and we will inform you when this comes into operation.
- There have been refurbishments to three ICT suites over the holiday and, in the next two weeks, both our broadband and Wi-Fi are going to have significant upgrades. I hope students and staff will notice the benefit.

Reading Programme

Our staff were very busy on the two INSET days making preparations for the new term. Lorraine Graves our Subject Co-ordinator for English has introduced a new whole school reading programme called DEAR (Drop Everything and Read). Students in all year groups will be exploring a range of interesting books and other literacy activities throughout the year during their morning and afternoon tutorial sessions.
