We have been contacted by some concerned members of the public about incidents of unsafe behaviour by some of our students when walking to and from school. It is clear that some students are placing themselves and others at great risk in the manner they walk, ride or even 'scoot' to school. We are educating the students about the need for safe behaviour when travelling to and from school and would greatly appreciate your support in reinforcing this message at home. We have also shared the concerns raised with the Police in the hope that working together we can help prevent an unnecessary accident. Thank you for your support with this serious matter.

### **Parking**

We are still experiencing some issues in relation to picking up students at the end of the day. In particular, the Land Registry has reported an ongoing issue with cars parking and blocking the entrance to their site which is creating significant issues for their staff. Can I please request again that courtesy is shown to our neighbours when students are dropped off and collected and that we do not block entrances to houses or local businesses. Thank you for your support with this.

We have had a pleasing response to the invitation for parents to join a new Parents' Forum. The first meeting is on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November and one of the key objectives of this first meeting is to agree how the group will run and share the work it does.
