Dear Year 12 Parents & Carers

I hope you are all well. Thank you for filling out the Google Form from my letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> June. I am pleased to say that 100 Year 12 students have taken up our offer of some face to face lessons. I can now give you a little more detail about where students should go for their lessons.

As I said in the 5<sup>th</sup> June letter, at the centre of all of our planning has been keeping students and staff safe and ensuring that the requirement for 2 metre social distancing is met. It is vital that all student familiarise themselves with the rules outlined in that letter and act on them at all times.

Students **must be on time to their lessons** and leave the site as soon as their lesson finishes. Start and finish times have been planned carefully so that groups of students come into contact with as few people as possible. Students are encouraged to come on foot or cycle and should enter the school via the East Gate (Everdene). Students should then make their way (maintaining a social distance of at least 2 metres) through the gate which allows entry behind the Sixth Form Café (see map overleaf); staff and signs will help guide the way. Following the one way system, students should then make their way to the appropriate line up station between the Hub and the Sixth Form Block and stand on the next available yellow line. Students will be greeted at their line up point by a member of staff. At the time indicated in the table below, students will be directed to their classrooms via a hand sanitising station.

NB: Students coming by car must not arrive with anyone from outside their own household. If driving themselves they should park on site leaving a parking bay free between cars and make their way straight to the route at the back of the Sixth Form Café.
