Dear Parents and Year 11 students

I hope you are all keeping safe and well.

I am writing to you today to give you some key information regarding collection of hoodies, locker refunds and, most importantly, the plan for Results Day.

### **Results Day: Thursday 20th August 2020**

I am sure you appreciate that we are not able to have all 260 Year 11 students on site at the same time on Results Day, but we are keen to see all Year 11 students face-to-face and congratulate them on their achievements. Therefore, we have arranged a scheduled arrival that will need to be adhered to. This is, of course, to keep everyone safe.

We have tried to reduce the delay in receiving results as much as possible, but this will rely on you arriving at the designated time to maintain manageable numbers.

Please enter through the main Hub Avenue entrance and exit via the south, Café end of the Avenue.</li> <li>Results, hoodies and locker contents will be issued for each Tutor group alphabetically by surname: <b>A–L on the left (Maths)</b> side of the Avenue, <b>M–Z on the right (Science)</b> side of the Avenue.</li> <li>Results will only be available at your allocated time.</li> <li>Guidance for Post-16 courses will be available in the Avenue café area after you have your results. There will also be the opportunity to book an individual guidance session on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August using this <a href="#">Google Form Link</a>. These can be via phone, video meet or face-to-face meeting at school.</li> <li>If you are unable to collect your results, students can either email Mr Bartlett: lbartlett@budmouth-aspirations.org and designate a named adult to collect their results. This person must arrive at the allocated tutor group time with photo ID. Alternatively, the student can email Mr Bartlett and request to receive the results electronically. Please can we ask that you only remain on site for as short a period of time as possible, this is to avoid any large groups forming. If students do want to bring an adult along, please can we ask that this is limited to only one adult per student.

### **Appeals & Autumn Exams**

The Awarding Bodies are working with JCQ to produce a comprehensive guide for centres on this summer's appeals process which will complement the information provided in Ofqual's guidance, once the final version is published (consultation concludes on 14th July). We will also provide information for learners and their parents, so they are aware of how we can support them, if they wish to appeal their final qualification result. It has been confirmed that if a student is unhappy with the grade awarded by the examining body, they will have the opportunity to sit any of their exams during the autumn term if they wish to. GCSE exam entries need to be requested in early September and the exams will take place in November. When we have more information about this we will make it available for you.

### **Leavers' hoodies**

We had hoped that we would have been able to get these out before the summer break. However, due to the on-going COVID-19 situation, delivery times are a lot longer than normal. Therefore, to make things easier these will be available for collection from a member of staff in the Hub on Results Day.

### **Lockers**

Due to the current situation, we are unable to allow students to walk around the Academy emptying their own lockers. With this in mind this will be done for you. Please note that locker deposits can only be returned once this form has been completed and the locker key has been returned. A member of staff will be on hand to help with any questions you might have.
