COVID-19 guidance

Please continue to test your child twice weekly at home and report the test results using the link below: <u>https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result</u>. Lateral flow test kits will be issued again next week to students that have previously received them and this will also include all Year 7 students that attended the Academy testing programme. If you have not requested kits previously, but would now like to receive them, please email Mr. Abbott on jabbot@budmouth-aspirations.org. Alternatively, test kits are available at local pharmacies online or by calling 119.

We have been in contact with the Department for Education, Public Health England and the NHS to receive guidance on the government's plan for vaccinating school children against COVID19. Although no schedule has been announced to us, we have understandably received a number of communications from parents concerned about the plan. Rest assured that whilst the school may host immunisation services, we have been advised that we will not be responsible for securing parents' or childrens' consent, for assessing Gillick competence or for mediating between parents and children who may disagree about whether or not to consent. It seems we will have no part in that. This is the role of registered nurses in the SAIS (School Age Immunisation Service), who have extensive experience and the expertise to handle these issues and are professionally accountable for their decisions. Legal accountability for offering COVID-19 vaccines to children and young people sits with the SAIS and not with the Academy.

Many of his recruits were not even aware they were good runners until they gave it a go. Joining the club just to keep fit, gain stamina for other sports or just to accompany a friend, for example is a great idea to get the most out of school life. The club is on Monday after school and it would be great to see students volunteer, not necessarily with the aim of running competitively but because running has so many other physical and mental benefits.

6th Form Employability Diploma

Having to say goodbye to our Year 11 far too early last year was very difficult. However, we are delighted that we have welcomed the majority of them back into Year 12 and they are settling into 6th Form life very well. We are pleased that our highly successful CEIL programme has been recognised by the Trust and has now been rolled out in other academies. We have been working hard to develop this even further and have created a new 'Employability Diploma' that will help support students' learning and develop those wider skills that they will need long after they have left school.

Last week, eight of our senior CCF Cadets were given the opportunity to travel to Exeter and listen to Kenton Cool deliver a motivational talk. Kenton Cool is one of the world's leading high-altitude climbers and also a highly engaging and inspiring motivational speaker. He has successfully climbed Mount Everest fifteen times. It was a great evening of motivational talk and supported our Academy vision of following dreams whilst being inspired in the present. His catch phrase of 'Get it done' certainly made an impression.

Homework

One positive thing to come out of the closure of schools was the very fast development of 'Google Classroom' in supporting independent learning. This will continue to be the main way that we will set homework for all students. To avoid duplication, staff will not therefore be setting homework on SIMS separately. Therefore we have removed this module from the SIMS Parent App and the SIMS Student App. Mr Clark (Assistant Principal) is leading our developments with online learning and we will be able to confirm soon how you can stay aware of homework that has been set so you can help support your children with their organisation and planning.
