Years 10 and 11 English Trip to Weymouth Pavilion
'Macbeth' Wednesday 13th October 2021 from 7:30pm to 10pm.

Due to the disruption that the COVID pandemic has caused, students have not been able to experience many extra-curricular trips in almost two years. However, now that restrictions are easing and we are settling back into school life, we would like to give students the opportunity to deepen their cultural capital and attend a production of 'Macbeth' at Weymouth Pavilion on **Wednesday 13th October 2021 from 7:30pm to 10pm.**

This is a fantastic opportunity for students to revise their understanding of a key text which forms a significant section of their GCSE English Literature exam, and also to experience the impact of a Shakespeare play live. We hope that as many students as possible will take up this exciting opportunity.

Due to this event taking place outside of school hours, transport **will not** be provided. Students will be expected to arrive promptly by 7:00pm outside Weymouth Pavilion to collect their tickets from staff. Students will not be required to wear school uniform but will be representing Budmouth and therefore adhering to our very high behaviour expectations. Refreshments are available at the Pavilion and your child is welcome to bring money to use in the shop or cafe if they wish.

Tickets are limited and we ask that the £12 ticket charge is paid via Pay360 Education Payments (Formally SIMS Pay) Pay by **Friday 24th September**. If you require financial assistance for your son or daughter in order to be able to attend then please do get in touch using my email address below. This particularly applies to students in receipt of free school meals.

Please note that staff will not be supervising collection from the Pavilion and that students must ensure that they have agreed travel home with their parents/carers.

We hope your child joins us for this theatre trip and finds the experience of seeing the play live both enjoyable and informative.
