We are offering students in Year 9 the opportunity to visit the Eden Project in Cornwall on Friday 13th May 2022.


Year 9 students will soon be studying Ecosystems and World Biomes in Geography. This trip will enable your child to experience the Tropics, Mediterranean and UK Maritime biomes first hand and to learn about how important they are to humans and what impacts we are having on them. We would encourage any student who has decided to take Geography as one of their GCSE options to consider going on this trip.

The cost of the trip is £25.00 and covers the cost of the coach, entry to the Eden Project, an educational workshop provided by the Eden staff and administration costs. We have 50 places available on this trip and they will be allocated on a first come first served basis. As we will be leaving Budmouth promptly at 7.00am on Friday, please ensure your child is at Budmouth by **6.50am**. We intend to leave the Eden Project at 4.00pm and arrive back at Budmouth by 8.00pm. Please ensure arrangements are made for your child to get home safely.

If you would like your child to be considered for this visit, spaces will be allocated by payment of £25.00 using the Pay 360 website. All students' medical and contact information will be collected from the initial consent form completed at the beginning of each school year. Please make sure that information is up to date via the Data Collection area on the Sims Parent App (you will have received an email from school regarding this before February half-term).
