Dear Parent/Carer

We are fast approaching our final training weekend for Ten Tor 2022. The good news is that we have now been allocated 3 x 35 mile and 2 x 45 mile teams. We will be making the final team selections after this final training walk so it is vital for all students to attend. The teams will be walking in the local Dorset area over the weekend. We will be focusing on the need for a quick morning route on Sunday as well. The walk has been discussed with your son/daughter at the planning meeting held this week. This letter is for your information.

The itinerary for the walk is as follows:

Friday 29 th April 2022	
08.00	Packed bags to CCF store
15.00	Group kit issue and full kit check, all bags will be unpacked, and group kit packed. Bags loaded onto the van.
Saturday 30 th April 2022	
07.25	Arrive at Budmouth, outside Sports Centre
07.30	Depart for start locations in Budmouth Minibus
08.00	All teams set off from start locations
During day	Remote Supervision of teams by staff on the planned routes
17.00- 19.00	Teams arrive at Tatton Campsite
19.00	Set up camp and cook food
21.00	Lights out for teams
Sunday 1 st May 2022	
06.00	Teams get up, cook breakfast and pack away camp
07.00	Teams start walking – following the planned route
13.00	Teams arrive in Weymouth - can be collected from finish or driven back to Budmouth

Full kit will need to be carried by all team members. Team members must make sure they have everything they need. Personal safety and Group kit will be issued at the Friday kit check. Rucksacks can be borrowed on Thursday 28th ready for packing. Maps and trackers will be provided on Saturday morning.

Team members must bring with them snacks and lunch for both days. On the Parental Permission Form there is a question regarding the two hot meals they can choose for Saturday evening and Sunday morning (all of which must be cooked on site). The cost for these is included in the charge for this event.

Please complete the Event 6 Ten Tors Parental Permission Form, which is on Budmouth Academy's website, by Monday 25th April. The charge for this training weekend will be £25.00. This is to cover the cost of insurance, two meals, camp site fees and stove fuel.
