Protocol for Virtual Parents' Evenings

- Make sure that the meeting is taking place in a quiet space of the house and in an appropriate room e.g. kitchen, lounge, study and not in a bedroom.
- As in our face to face parent meetings, your child is welcome to take part. Please make sure a parent/carer is always in the room with your child during the meeting.
- Other siblings should not be in the room when the meeting is taking place.
- No conversations should be recorded.
- Both teachers and parents have the choice of using audio or video. Please use video where possible so that participants can see each other.
- Please try to be on time as the slot times are not flexible at all and will start/finish exactly on time.
- At Budmouth Academy we are committed to positive, constructive relationships between staff and parents/carers and it is important that this continues. Therefore, please note that in the extremely unlikely event of verbal abuse, staff will end the conversation and refer the matter to the Senior Leadership Team.
