Watch a movie or documentary about an artist or Art movement. There are literally hundreds on YouTube. Series like Masters of Photography or the film Frida, about Frida Kahlo the painter.

Always do more than the set work!!! If you have been asked to do 2 drawings then do 4. Use 2 different materials not just one.
