The focus for the evening is supporting your child to maximise their achievements this year and beyond. The evening will start with a presentation by myself, which will be followed by a range of sessions in the Hub. These sessions focus on the skills needed to revise independently and also look after yourself, physically and mentally, as you move towards the exams season. All of your child's subjects will be represented in the Hub and staff will be on hand to provide information about exams and offer resources and guidance to support students' success. The evening is designed for students to attend with parents however please do discuss the relevance of the evening with your child, in particular if they are following a vocational study programme.
