Year 6 Transition to Budmouth Academy

A warm welcome to parents of our new Year 7 cohort in September and it is with great excitement that we also begin to welcome our newest students for 2023. I am delighted to confirm that your child has been offered a place in Year 7 at Budmouth Academy and we are aware that this is an exciting and perhaps also a nervous time for all young people. Thank you for choosing us! We are very pleased to welcome another year group that is full, with all 260 places having been allocated, and there is now a waiting list and long series of appeals scheduled for those still wishing to join us as their first choice school. So, whether you are joining us as a parent for the first time, or if you already have a child with us, welcome to Budmouth!

W/C 12th June	Letters sent to parents including; - Tutor and school allocation - Dates and details of the information evening - Details of the transition day
Tuesday 20th June 6.30pm	Year 6 Information Evening at Budmouth A face to face presentation about the transition process for parents and children, with an opportunity to ask questions about year 7 transition.
Tuesday 4th July	Transition Day at Budmouth Academy A good chance for the students to meet their new classmates and get to know their new school a little better.
Monday 4th September	Yr 7 Induction Day (1st day of term for Year 7)

In the meantime, our staff are already working hard behind the scenes to get things ready. Uniform and Budmouth Academy Used Uniform Service

We are proud of how smart our students look, but we are also keen to support parents during this difficult period, where the cost of living is increasing so rapidly. Therefore, I am pleased to inform you that from January this year, Budmouth Academy school uniform is available to purchase via dual supply, with an additional choice of a local supplier. From this date you will have the choice of purchasing your uniform online from Brigade, or purchasing it from local supplier DEP (Dorset Embroidery & Printwear Ltd on Lynch Lane).

Please note that from 1st September 2023 we are making changes to our current PE kit. These changes have been implemented to help parents source items easier and cheaper than before. The main changes are that we will have only one option of a PE top and PE jumper (both available to purchase via DEP only) and we will be changing our navy bottoms to <u>black</u>. The new kit will be compulsory for students entering Year 7 from September 2023. A reminder also please, that black socks are a compulsory part of any uniform here at Budmouth. Some schools also allow black trainers to be worn each day, but we do not.

We have also recently set up our very own donated uniform service here at Budmouth. If you have any spare Budmouth Academy uniform that is clean and in good condition and you are willing to donate to the school, please could you or your child bring it into the main school office? We have set up a free second hand uniform service so any spare uniform can be reused within the school; for example this service can be used for students who may be new to the school, who have forgotten certain items on a day to day basis, have misplaced uniform items and for those who cannot afford to replace it. We are also pleased to announce that in partnership with parents, there is now a Facebook page called "Budmouth Academy Used Uniform".
