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There are issues with Year 10s and 6th for musing the Hub canteen	MH made it clear that the Hub canteen is for <b>Year 11 only.</b>
Cartons are too small	Canteen staff explained that there are a range of sizes and cost is relative to the size. The Blue dot deal will be promoted better as it is very good value.
There is a lack of labelling on the products.	All food will be labelled clearly from 28th March 2023
There is not enough food in the hub.	Canteen staff said that they were responding to feedback that students wanted more 'street food' but can look at this again.
Could we have a wider choice of condiments.	Canteen staff said they were happy to look at this and to trial some dispensers. They need to be used properly or will be removed.
The cost of food is high	Canteen staff made it clear that inflation was high and all of their costs had increased. They have done their very best not to increase prices. Blue dot meal deal is value for money and food can be bought at the end of the day at a reduced rate.
