Year 8 Geography Trip to Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door - Week Monday 26th June to Friday 30th June 2023

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the Year 8 Geography course we are studying coasts this term. To enhance students' understanding and knowledge of this topic, we are planning a visit to Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door. Students will be able to study the physical and human features of the area by completing fieldwork activities. Below is a table that shows when each class will go on this field trip.

Monday 26th June 2023	Students in 8H and 8M
Tuesday 27th June 2023	Students in 8B and 8T
Wednesday 28th June 2023	Students in 80 and 8U
Thursday 29th June 2023	Students in 8D only
Friday 30th June 2023	Students in 8A and 8C

Students will need to come to school as usual and register in tutor time. At 08.50 students will need to meet outside the Sports Centre on the footpath, the gates will be unlocked so students can do this. Students will be supervised for the duration of the field trip. Students do not need to wear Budmouth uniform but will need to wear suitable clothing for being outside. We will discuss this in lessons before the date that the class goes on the field trip and use the weather forecast to help students work out what to wear. Students will need to bring waterproofs if the forecast is for rain or a sunhat and sunscreen if sunshine. Sensible shoes such as trainers or walking shoes need to be worn. If any students arrive on the day wearing flip flops or sandals they will not be able to go on the trip and will need to stay at Budmouth for the day. Students will need to bring a packed lunch, drink in a screw top bottle (no cans or energy drinks) and some spending money for an ice cream or small souvenir. We will be back at Budmouth before 14.50 in time for students to go home as usual.

We will be travelling by coach and it is necessary to ask for £10.50 per student to cover the cost of this. Payment can be made using the Pay360 website. All students' medical and contact information will be collected from the initial consent form completed at the beginning of each school year. Please make sure that this information is up to date via the data collection area on the SIMS parent App.
