

Higher GCSE grades linked to lifetime earnings boost

1 grade higher across all subjects on average means £200,000 increased earnings across your working life.

1 grade in 1 subject on average means £23,000 more across your working life.

Attendance

90% of young people with attendance rates below 85% fail to achieve five or more good grades of GCSE and around one third achieve no GCSEs at all

A child who is absent a day of school per week misses an equivalent of two years of their school life.





