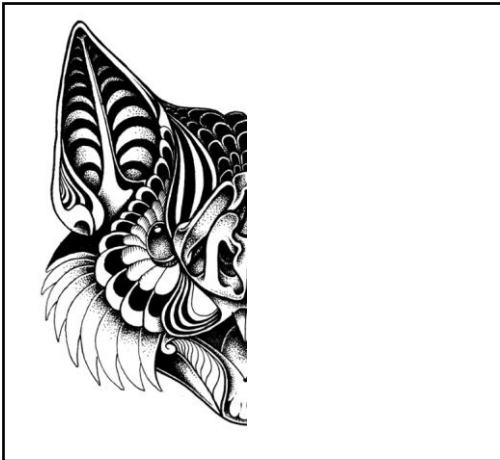
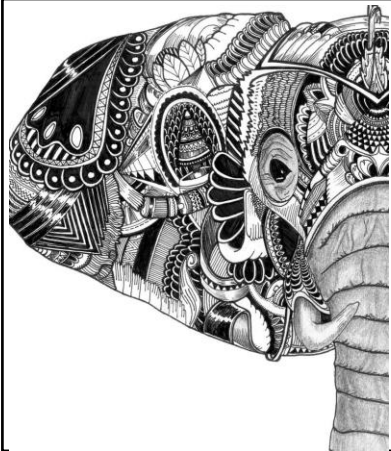


Learning Objective: To create detailed drawings of a section of tiger, focusing on pattern and texture.

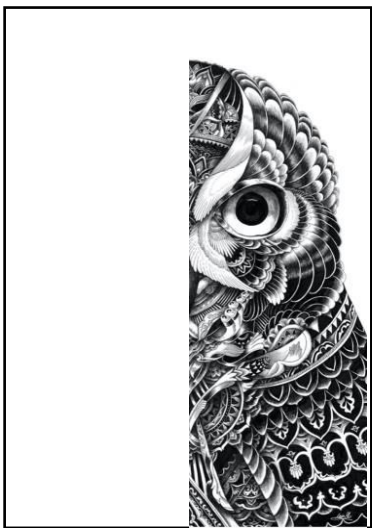
Use a drawing pencil to complete the other half of the tigers face. Look at where the facial features and patterns are at the centre to help you start.

1 - If you don't have a 'split' tub ask an adult to help cut a margarine tub.



2 - Cut two ear shapes from card, slit them and pull into a 3D shape and attach.



3 - Make fur to go inside the ears.



4 - Make more fur for the top and the sides.

5 - Roll foil up for eyes, and make card eyelids.



6 - Make a card 'muzzle' and a furry chin.



7 - Then make a nose, and some sharp teeth.



8 - Glue on scrap card for more fur ... and maybe whiskers?



9 - Always paint lighter colours on first ...
