Dear Parent/ Carer

As we approach the end of this half term, I would like to thank the students for their fantastic, progress, behaviour and effort in their Maths and English lessons.

We are planning a group outing to Kingston Maurward Animal Park and Gardens, where students can learn about animal and plant care, and also gather inspiration for a creative writing project back at school.

The trip will be on **Friday 23rd February 2024**.
