End of Year Assessment/Exams for Year 10

As we work through the final term of this academic year, I am writing to you to outline our plans for the end of year exams, and to explain how this links to parental reports.

Year 10 will be approaching their final year of KS4 courses and it is important that they get a chance to prepare and experience assessments in a more formal setting. There is no better preparation for public examinations than completing exams in a real formal setting, where children get to experience the routine, rules and timings of the exams, prior to the real thing.

Between April 29th and May 24th Year 10 will undertake end of year exams/assessments. English, Maths, Science and Geography/History will take place in the Gym Halls and other subjects will be completed in timetabled lessons.
