Year 8 Geography Trip to Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door - Monday 17th June to Friday 21st June 2024

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the Year 8 Geography course we are studying coasts this term. To enhance students' understanding and knowledge of this topic, we are planning a visit to Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door. Students will be able to study the physical and human features of the area by completing fieldwork activities. Below is a table that shows when each class will go on this field trip.

Monday 17th June 2024	Students in 8O and 8U
Tuesday 18th June 2024	Students in 8H and 8T
Wednesday 19th June 2024	Students in 8A and 8B
Thursday 20th June 2024	Students in 8D and 8M
Friday 21st June 2024	Students in 8C only

Students will need to come to school as usual and register in tutor time. At 08.50 they will need to meet outside the Sports Centre on the footpath ready to board the coach; the gates will be unlocked so they can do this. Students do not need to wear their Budmouth uniform but will need to wear clothing suitable for being outside. We will discuss this in lessons before the date of your child's field trip and use the weather forecast to help students work out what to wear. Students will need to bring waterproofs if the forecast is for rain or a sunhat and sunscreen if sunshine. Sensible shoes such as trainers or walking shoes must be worn. If any students arrive on the day wearing flip flops or sandals they will not be able to go on the trip and will need to stay at Budmouth for the day. Students will need to bring a packed lunch, a drink in a screw top bottle (no cans or energy drinks) and some spending money for an ice cream or small souvenir. We will be back at Budmouth before 14.50 in time for students to go home as usual. Please be advised that students will be supervised for the duration of the trip.

The cost of the trip is £12.00 per student. Payment can be made using the Parent Mail app. All students' medical and contact information will be taken from the information we hold on Arbor.
